I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with those given in the ~~original~~ freeboard report and I have found them to be in agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient condition. Repairs now carried out -

3 hatch coaming on upper Deck, doublers fitted port, starboard & aft in way of steam pipes. Deck Budge & space and tween decks at aft end of upper deck modified to Convention requirements. - All vent wood plugs and canvas covers renewed. All tarpaulins for exposed ways renewed, 4 per hatch. Wood batches, 7 in No. renewed and all battering elements supplied in accordance with requirements. 402 portholes & deadlights bered and 12 new glasses fitted.

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given ^{in assignment letter} on ~~certificate~~ No. _____ dated 3 Oct. 1945 which is returned herewith.
