Dear Sirs,

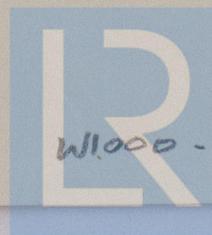
I duly received your letter of the 30th ultimo respecting the "EMPIRE DEBIN" and in confirmation of my telephonic reply I have to say it is considered the conditions of assignment generally satisfy the requirements of the Rules for an existing ship with the exception of the doors into the enclosed superstructure at the after end of the Freeboard Deck. These should be replaced by hinged wood doors of solid strong construction at least 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " in thickness and without hinged top portions.

I shall be glad if you will arrange accordingly.
