THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Superintendent of The Eastern Gas & Fuel Associates attend the S.S. "WINDING GULF" Official Number 216767 at Boston, Mass., at Mobile, Alabama on the 9th day of April 1943, for the purpose of inspecting (a) protection of openings, (b) guard rails, (c) freeing ports, (d) means of access to crew's quarters, and found same to have been maintained in an effective condition; also, that no alterations had been made to hull or superstructures which would affect the calculations determining the position of the load lines.

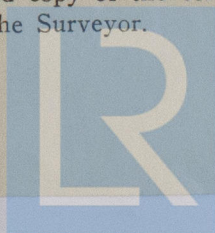
An Annual Survey has been carried out in accordance with the Regulations of The Commandant, United States Coast Guard.
