(a) the condition of openings, (b) guard rails, (c) freeing ports, (d) means of access to deck, and found same to have been maintained in an effective condition; also, no alterations had been made to hull or superstructures which would affect the calculation of the position of the load lines.

The vessel was examined while lying afloat at the Massachusetts Koppers Coal Company Pier, East Boston, Mass.

The load lines as assigned under the amendment of the 3rd Act, to the Coastwise Load Line Act, have now been marked on the vessel's sides.


