the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Master of the steamer "WAVE GOVERNOR" attend on board the steel screw steamers "TORTUGUERO" 5285 tons gross of Glasgow, and "ALBION STAR" 7946 tons gross of London, for the purpose of ascertaining the nature and extent of damage, if any, stated to have been caused through contact with the steamer "WAVE GOVERNOR" when this vessel was entering the port of Avonmouth on the 27th December, 1947. 100%

Upon examination on the 29th December, 1947, the undersigned Surveyor found :-

"TORTUGUERO" :- Starboard side :- one poop deck awning stanchion to be buckled and half round moulding in way of poop to be rubbed and rivets started.

The undersigned Surveyor recommended as permanent repair that the buckled poop deck awning stanchion be removed, faired and afterwards refitted in place. The started rivets in half round moulding, approximately six (6) in number, to be overhauled and hardened up as found necessary.

The foregoing recommendation was made for the purpose of placing the vessel in as good condition as before the damage in question was sustained.

"ALBION STAR" :- Evidence of paint work scrubbed, shell plating, starboard side forward but no damage to shell plating itself and under the circumstances no recommendations were considered necessary.
