Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in 1939

The shelter tween deck space has now been taken off the tonnage and the following alterations have been effected at this time.

The beam and wood decking of the tonnage opening in the shelter deck have been removed and hatch covers with efficient temporary means of closing are now fitted.

The freeing ports and scuppers in the tonnage well have now been opened.

The tonnage stated on the loadline certificate and certified copy is now 9142 and the closing appliances of the tonnage opening are efficient temporary covers.
