We are in receipt of your letter of the 25th instant in reply to ours of the 21st idem, and note the Committee consider the validity of the contemplated General Examination should be limited to six months, by which time the ship should be submitted to the requisite Special Survey. We will, therefore, make every endeavour to get a repairer to take the ship in hand for Special Survey within the six months of completion of the General Examination.

We may mention, we did our utmost to influence Swan Hunter and Wigham Richardson Ltd to undertake the Special Survey on this occasion, but owing to their heavy commitments they were unable to take it in hand.

With reference to your concluding paragraph, we have to advise you we are booking up the ships for Special Survey as far as the repairers will take them, and for your information, we have stemmed ships for Special Survey as follows:-
