Dear Sirs, Steamer "BRITISH VETERAN"

With reference to the telephone conversation with Mr. Downey on the 13th ultimo, I have to acquaint you a report has now been received from the Society's Antwerp Surveyors in connection with the Modified General Examination carried out by them on this vessel during June and July. The Surveyors state that owing to the extent of the general wastage of the longitudinals, transverses and their attachments, bulkheads and plating etc., they consider the vessel's present limited class should only be continued for a maximum of six months.

In the circumstances, the Committee have assigned a notation of Examined (Mod.) 7,48, valid for a period of six months, on the expiration of which it is considered essential for the vessel to be properly cleaned and examined, and all necessary repairs effected. A certificate in respect thereof is enclosed in duplicate.
