CYELSE.—Malin Head Radio, Mar. 13. —
Following received from Coastguard,
Stornoway, at 9.3 a.m., G.M.T.: British
trawler Cyelse ashore Castlebay, Isle of
Barra. Castlebay lifeboat has been
launched to assistance.

Castlebay, Mar. 13. — Steam
trawler Cyelse, of Fleetwood, on a reef
Castlebay harbour southern end north
beach Vatersay Island. Vessel had been
attempting refloat steam trawler BEN
BHEULA. Crew taken off until weather
moderates. It is feared vessel is
damaged.

Malin Head, Mar. 13. —
Following received from Coastguard,
Stornoway, at 9.9 a.m., G.M.T.: Barra
lifeboat now returned with 14 survivors
from British trawler Cyelse.

Castlebay, Mar. 13. — Fleet-
wood trawler Cyelse has been blown off
reef into deep water. Nothing visible,
rear back broken. — Lloyd's Agent.
