SOEGIO.—Balik Papan, Feb. 14. — At 6 p.m., Macassar time, Feb. 12, sea-going steam tug Soegio, owners Bataafsche Petroleum Maatschappij, struck a mine of unknown type in position lat. 116 33 E., long. 2 36 S., and sank. Weather fine; non-dangerous area.

SOEGIO.—Macassar, Feb. 16.—Following received from Macassar Radio to-day: Following message received from motor vessel Betoeran at 5 50 p.m., Java time, on Feb. 14: Tug Soegio, PKLZ, struck a mine in clear area in position lat. 2 36 S., long. 116 33 E. Four of crew missing, four severely injured, remainder saved by "Higgingsboat" at 6 p.m. on Feb. 12. (See issue of Feb. 16.)
