"5 B.H. to U.Dk. After pk. & Int.Bk. forward to 2nd Dk."

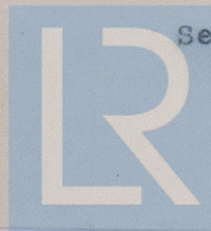
