Caen Report III - s.s. VENDEMIARE -

Chantiers Navals Français. Yd.n° 37

Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of 13th instant respecting the above vessel, I beg to enclose a signed copy of the contract signed between the late Owners and the Builders which includes the provision of Bureau Veritas certificates for the anchors and chains etc. being supplied to the above vessel and her sisters and which will, I trust, be accepted as the Owners written consent. I attached a letter dated 21st July which I received from the Principal Surveyor in France on this subject. The letter of 5th January last to which you refer I have no trace of and I suggest it was addressed to you from the Paris Office by Mr Ward.

As requested I enclose the steel invoice from Trignac certified by the Nantes Surveyors which includes the stem bars for the six vessels building. The sternframe was cast by the Aciéries Nantaises and was examined, tested and certified by the Marine Nationale 30th December 1920.

A signed copy dated 27th October 1920 of the Marine Nationale Certificate for four cast steel quadrants supplied is also enclosed. The steering chains have been tested and certified by the Havre Surveyors.


