Chantiers Navals Français Yd.N° 37-s.s.Vendémiaire

Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of 21st instant respecting the Caen Report n° IIO on the above vessel, I beg to inform you this steamer is still lying, practically complete, at the Builders Yard. The life boats made in England to Board of Trade requirements have now been delivered : but the Builders have not yet received the Board of Trade tonnages. Nor have they yet received the Certificate of Tests from the Bureau Veritas for the Chain Cables, in order that the markings on the cables supplied may be compared with the Certificates of Tests, by myself.

I beg to refer you to my letter of 22nd August last accompanying my Report IIO.

The Builders anticipate the trial of the vessel at sea will be carried out next month, and they state that they await a crew being supplied by the Owners to this effect.

The Society's Surveyors at Havre are duly kept informed of the progress of the machinery work in the Caen district.

The Caen Report IIO was despatched prior to my going holiday leave of absence.
