Will you please send to this office the Report which has been furnished to you probably by the Nantes Office.

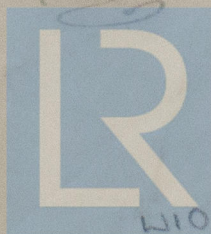
