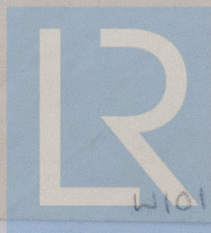
The Builders have not yet received from the Bureau Veritas the certificate of Tests for the Chain cables. The comparison of the markings remains to be done. I shall duly report this verification.
