With reference to my enclosed Report n° 110. I beg to inform you this vessel was recently measured by the Board of Trade at the request of the new Owners. The Board of Trade tonnages have not yet been received. The fees are rendered in the French tonnage, a copy of the Certificat de Jauge provisoire is attached. The Board of Trade tonnages and dimensions will be forwarded to you in due course.

The Builders have not yet received from the Bureau Britas the certificate of Tests for the Chain cables. The comparison of the markings remains to be done. I shall duly report this verification.

The vessel is lying at the Builders Yard awaiting arrival from England of Life boats, lights, etc, to meet the requirements of the Board of Trade.
