Elder Dempster Lines Ltd., attend and the twin screw motor yacht 'AARLA' on September, 13th, 1945 for the purpose of extending an Interim Certificate which had been issued at Oporto, Portugal, on September, 4th, 1945, on the authority of the vessel, in order that she may continue her voyage from Oporto to the River Clyde.

The main engines were examined running under working conditions, lubricating oil pressures with and without the Stand-by operating oil pump running were noted and all found to be satisfactory. The main motors were also examined whilst being reversed. The generators and steering gear were also examined under working conditions.

The machinery of this vessel as far as can be ascertained under the above conditions and without opening up for a complete examination, is efficient and the vessel is eligible in my opinion to proceed on her voyage to the River Clyde which is her destination.
