Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 21st instant forwarding plans in connexion with the proposed reclassification of the Yacht "AAR V", and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you that the machinery of this vessel will be accepted and notations of NE 1931 and LMC (with date), without the distinguishing mark+, assigned, provided the working parts of the machinery be opened up, examined and found in good order, the sizes of shafting be in accordance with the plans; the pumping arrangements be examined and found in good order, a donkey pump direct bilge suction be fitted in the engine room, if this is not already provided; the suction valves on the oil fuel daily service and storage tanks be controlled from a position outside the compartments in which the tanks are situated, and the air and sounding pipes to these tanks be fitted in accordance with the requirements of the Rules.

It is concluded that the electric motor driving the emergency air compressor can be worked for a reasonable length of time from the electric storage batteries.

The plans are being returned, under separate cover.
