With regard to the Loadline Certificate, it is understood the last one was issued at Freetown on the 3rd July, 1945, but this Certificate was not issued by a Surveyor to this Society.

The matter has been taken up with Mr. Ross Innes, who was the Surveyor at Freetown at the time, and he has replied that no such document was issued by him. It is therefore assumed that the survey on the 3rd July was held by either a Representative of the Ministry of War Transport, or Lloyd's Agents at Freetown, and you may consider it desirable to take the point up with the parties concerned.

Mr. Ross Innes has, however, written to Lloyd's Agents at Freetown on the subject and has promised to furnish me with their remarks when received.

An account for the sum of £6.15.0 is enclosed herewith to cover the bare cost of production of the above-listed documents.
