Twin Screw - $\frac{14'' - 22'' - 36''}{21''}$ x 160 lbs.W.P.

Propellers 9'-3" dia.

60 glands to be fitted to stern tube

Subject to the above being correct, the sizes as shown are in order and can be accepted, provided everything else is to your entire satisfaction.
