We enclose herewith Reports C.11 and C.12(a) for the above vessel, and shall be pleased to receive the freeboard certificate and 2 copies to be issued say 1st February, 1949.

The Official Number and gross tonnage figures are not yet available, but will be entered on the certificate and copies before being issued.

The vessel is due to carry out sea trials commencing on the 9th February, 1949 and will return to her berth in Belfast for completion by the 15th February, 1949.

With reference to your letter of the 21st instant, it will be noted that the flush hatches at Nos. 3 and 4 on the Promenade deck are fitted with tarpaulins and battening arrangements as approved, and that the 18" high coaming is now fitted to the No. 5 hatchway on the Freeboard deck.
