Re: 46257/M - m.v. "MATRONA".

We thank you for your letter of the 10th instant and note that we seem to be under a misapprehension that Mr. McIntyre, the surveyor to the Society was stationed in Liverpool in October last when the above ship overturned.

We are not so much concerned whether Mr. McIntyre was actually in this city when the vessel overturned, but we are interested to know whether Mr. McIntyre did certain survey work on the vessel before it overturned. If this is so we are wondering whether you would be so kind as to grant us facilities to see *Mr* McIntyre.
