

With reference to the settling down of the Upper Tween Deck in No. 3 hold of above vessel - I have to-day communicated with Captain Simpson not to call in Lloyd's Surveyor at the port of loading unless any further damage appears, and shall be obliged if, in making your report, you will also refrain from communicating with him.

My reason for this is, that he, perhaps not fully understanding the situation, might deem it necessary for the repairs, or temporary ones, to be put in hand previous to loading, and naturally do not wish for any delay on the first voyage when the damage can be rectified on the ship's return without causing detention.
