Messrs. Lindsay Burnet & Co. Survey during construction one Steel Manoeuvring Air Reservoir No. 5936 for the oil engined Messrs. Harland & Wolff's G.O. 45 Messrs. Barclay, Curle & Co's No. 519.

The material has been tested by the Surveyors to this Society.

The scantlings are in accordance with the Rules for a working pressure of 356 lbs. per square inch. The reservoir was tested in my presence on the 15th April, 1918 by hydraulic pressure to 712 lbs. per square inch, shewed no signs of weakness and was found sound and tight at that pressure.

The working pressure should not exceed three hundred and fifty six pounds per square inch.
