Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your memorandum of the 20th instant, with enclosure, respecting the Steamer "HOPESTAR", and note that the Owners anticipate renewing the thermal engine crankshaft on the vessel's return to this Country at about the end of next month.

The case has been submitted to the Committee at their Meeting today and I have to inform you that they are agreeable to the above arrangement, but I am directed to add that should the renewal of the thermal engine crankshaft be unduly delayed beyond the end of March, the Committee consider that arrangements should be made for a further examination of the existing crankshaft.
