It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as classed; subject to permanent repairs to indented shell plates etc. (p & s) and to distorted bulkheads (p.s) at aft end of No. 1 hold, to No. 4 D.B. tank top and margin plate in way of Deep Tank (p.s) and to defective shell rivets in No. 2 hold (p.s) at the first convenient opportunity and to Deep Tank being permanently repaired on vessel's arrival in the U.K.
