VESSEL'S NAME HOPESTAR REPORT Nwc No. 103847

The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The NOTATION of 'S.S. Nwc - 4,46' is DEFERRED for completion. An 'Examined' record of '4,46', with a 12 months' validity, is assigned meantime.

The class is subject to permanent repairs to indented shell plates etc. (p & s) and to distorted bulkheads (p.s) at aft end of No. 1 hold, also to No. 4 D.B. tank top and margin plate in way of deep tank (p.s) at the first convenient opportunity, to No. 4 D.B. tank being tested in way of deep tank (p.s) on vessel's arrival at a N. American port, and to the deep tank being permanently repaired by 10,46.

The NEWCASTLE-ON-TYNE Surveyors report the vessel examined afloat on account of damage through striking quay wall and temporary repairs effected to indented shell plating etc. in way of cross bunker. The Surveyors recommend permanent repairs at the first convenient opportunity.

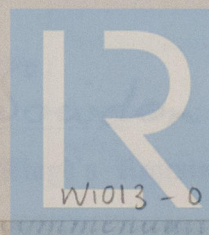
