The class is subject to permanent repairs to indented shell plating in way of Nos. 1 & 2 holds (p.s.) and to indented bottom plating at the first convenient opportunity, also to scupper pipe abaft deep tank being led to the bilges (p & s).

The NEWCASTLE Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated and on account of heavy weather damage repairs effected to the deep tank.

On account of damage by "depth charges" repairs to bilge keel riveting effected.

On account of wear and tear, additional repairs effected to deep tank forward bulkhead in way of dynamo flat.

Scupper pipes, as above, now fitted.

It is submitted the vessel is eligible to remain as classed with record of survey 1.44 subject as above except as regards scupper pipes.
