Desuperheaters.

I duly received your letter of the 15th instant, forwarding plans, in triplicate, of De-superheater proposed in the case of the above vessel, and I have to inform you that these plans will be approved for a working pressure of 235 lb. per sq. inch, provided the De-superheater be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

It is noted that it is proposed to use stock tubing for the manufacture of the coils, and it is concluded that the material has been tested by the Society's Surveyors. If, however, this is not the case, check tests should be carried out in the presence of the Surveyors.

One copy of each plan is returned herewith, and it is noted that plans of replace superheater elements will be submitted in due course.
