I return herewith two copies of plan No.43740, forwarded with your letter of the 13th instant, showing the modifications to the boiler pipe arrangements, and have to inform you that the same will be approved, provided the steel castings be made at Approved Works and tested as required by the Rules, the drainage arrangements be to your satisfaction, all pipes, valves and fittings subjected to steam of a temperature above 425°F be made of steel or other approved material and the work be carried out under the usual conditions of survey and testing.
