I shall be glad if you will ascertain and let me know what arrangements have been made for the vessel to be surveyed for the extension or renewal of the Freeboard Certificate which will expire on the 20th proximo.

At the same time I think it well to point out that the vessel will require to be generally examined in accordance with Circular 1772 before the end of next month.
