The Valparaiso Surveyor reports this vessel examined afloat and on account of damage through grabs, hold ladders bent, channels in bulkhead buckled, tank top plating indented, and cargo battens broken.

The Surveyor recommends permanent repairs on arrival in Europe where now bound.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey, subject as recommended.
