I have to acquaint you that in reply to an enquiry regarding the renewal of the Loadline Certificate in the case of the steamer "HOPESTAR", and the General Examination which will shortly be due in accordance with the terms of Circular 1772, the Owners have intimated that this vessel has been aground in Belfast Lough, and is now undergoing temporary repairs at your port, with a view to being towed to this Country for permanent repairs.
