on this date.

I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with those given in the original freeboard report and I have found them to be in agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient condition.

Most of the requirements of the special survey have been carried out at this time.

The notation S.S. NW4-46 is recommended on completion of the survey.

The alterations necessary to restore the vessel to "open shelter deck" have been carried out.

Repairs. 97 wood hatch covers renewed & minor repairs effected.

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given on certificate No. 23517 dated 18th April 1946. which has been placed on board the vessel. is returned herewith.
