on this date.



General Examination in lieu of Special Survey carried out, vessel afloat, and a number of repairs being effected, on completion of which it will be recommended that a notation of "Examined 2,45" (12 months) be assigned.

Freeboard Repairs:- 20 wood hatch covers renewed, otherwise satisfactory.

Load Line Certificate and certified copy extended until 28th February, 1946 and endorsed by W. J. Ferguson, 3rd February, 1945.

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given on certificate No. 17665 dated 23rd July, 1941 ~~which is returned herewith.~~
