In reply to your letter of 27th instant with regard to the "CHRISTINA DAWN" Report No. 13313, we have to inform you that the Master reported a heavy weather passage from the Bristol Channel, but that no damage claim was being made.

The fore deck plating (P.S.), poop bulkhead (S.S.), and fore peak upper shell plating were not fully caulked in way of new work. ?

No. 2 hatchway forward coaming small doubler was not fully welded. ?

Port hawse pipe shell flange, badly fractured, had a cement box under the forecastle flooring, but this was found to be ineffective, and the flange was E.W. externally and made tight temporarily. ?

All repairs were hose tested to the satisfaction of the Master, and the vessel sailed for the Bristol Channel without delay.
