Dear Sir,


I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 26th instant enclosing one from the Grangemouth Dockyard Co., Ltd., from which it is noted that they have been requested by the Owners of the Three Masted Auxiliary Motor Schooner "JOHN WILLIAMS V" to supply two additional thirty fathom lengths of 12/16" diameter Stud Link chain cable with the necessary joining and end shackled, and shall be glad if you will, in thanking the Grangemouth Dockyard Co. for the information supplied, inform them that due note will be made of this addition to the vessel's equipment. They will, of course, realise that it will not be possible, as this additional cable is to be shipped to Suva where the Society has no Surveyor stationed, to verify the fact that the additional chain is actually on board but if any indication can be given of the vessel's likelihood to call at a port where the Society is represented arrangements could be made for the matter to receive attention.
