Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your telegram of today requesting the Classification Certificates for the Auxiliary Screw 3 Masted Schooner "JOHN WILLIAMS V", and in compliance therewith I now enclose the Classification Certificates both for the hull and machinery. As, however, in the ordinary course the machinery certificate would have been forwarded to Manchester I have requested the Manchester Surveyors to obtain Messrs. L. Gardners' consent to the certificate being ~~forwarded~~ by you, and if this is in order you will be receiving a telegram from them tomorrow morning to this effect.

At the same time I have to add that with regard to your letter of the 28th ultimo respecting the spare lubricating oil pump, which is required to be fitted, that it must be understood that the certificates can only be issued when this pump has been actually fitted.
