

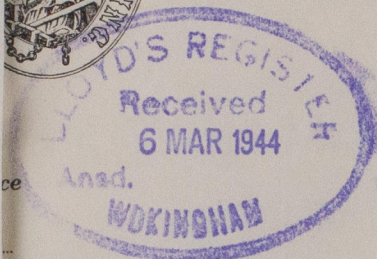

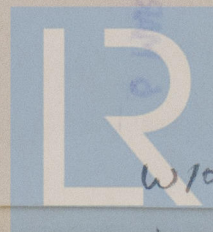
Dear Sir,
