Dear Sir,

With reference to Glasgow Report No. 50386, in respect of the Auxiliary Schooner "JOHN WILLIAMS, Messrs. The Grangemouth Dockyard Co's Yard No. 418, I have to inform you that it is observed this case has been reported on the form for steamers. If it is intended to claim the allowance for auxiliary power, the conditions of B.T. Circular 1515 should be complied with and full particulars should be submitted. If, on the other hand, it is desired that the freeboard should be that of a motor (full powered) vessel, full particulars of power, speed, displacement and sail area should be submitted for consideration.

The three plans are being retained meantime.


