The headers for this contract will be made from mild steel blooms selected from those in stock at our Works, manufactured by Steel, Peech & Tozer to your classification, mill certificate being available at our Works.

The elements will be made from solid cold drawn mild steel tubing, manufactured by Tubes Limited, Birmingham, having been made to your requirements and placed before you for inspection at our Works, the tube makers supplying mechanical test certificates and chemical analysis.

The cast steel elbows, selected from our stock, having been manufactured by Messrs. Renton & Fisher Ltd., Bathgate, to your requirements, inspection and hydraulic test at their Works before despatch.

The completed apparatus will be subject to your final hydraulic test and survey at our Works before despatch.
