With reference to your Report No. 9154 on the Electric Fittings of the Motor Vessel "LOCHMONAR", I have to request you will state whether earth lamps are fitted, or what other means are provided at the main switch board for indicating the state of the insulation of the system, as this is not mentioned in your report.

You should also state whether the size of the cable 26, to cooking boxes 7 & 9, viz one of 37/072, is correct as the maximum current allowed by the Rules for this size is 152 amperes.
