M. With reference to the S.S. "PORT DARWIN" building by Messrs. Workman, Clark & Co. Ltd., at Belfast, I have to inform you that this ^{vessel} is stated to be proceeding to your port where the Survey for Classification will be completed, and that to complete the Survey the following require to be done:-

Shelter deck to hose test. ✓
Downton pump and steam pumps to be tried on bilges. ✓
Hawsers, warps, etc. to examine and certificate ✓
of steel wires to produce. ✓
Some pipes in 'tween deck bunker and in after 'tween ✓
decks to be cased in. ✓
Scuppers in Refrigerating Engine room to fit with ✓
screw down valve on Upper Deck. ✓
Troughs in hospital to be fitted with plugs at ✓
Upper Deck. ✓
Watertight doors on bulkheads Nos. 103 & 112 to ✓
complete and examine. ✓
Rudder trunk to hose test. ✓
Boats checks to complete and Boats to put out. ✓

I shall be glad if you will arrange for this matter to receive the necessary attention, and for the report of the Survey to be forwarded in due course, with a view to the classification of the vessel.


