Reverting to my letter of the 24th ultimo in reply to yours of the 23rd ultimo regarding the passenger load line of the above vessel, we have now received from our Surveyors the final freeboard report and have assigned the freeboards as a cargo steamer, and are advising them an additional line at the position required by Table "C" of the Loadline Tables - namely 16 inches below the centre of the disc - is to be marked, to indicate the passenger line, and the certificates will be endorsed accordingly.
