We duly received your letter of 3rd March which we have referred to our Superintendents.

They have supplied us with extensive notes but we feel that it may not be really profitable to either side to continue this correspondence unduly.

There are however three points to which we must refer.

1. We are glad to note that you admit that Lloyds Register is not infallible.
2. We cannot accept the implication that the reports of your Surveyors go no further than to your Committee. We have in mind instances where, with the permission of an Owner, such information has been produced to a prospective purchaser.
3. To say the least it is unreasonable for an Owner not to know what notes are made against a ship, whether they are justified or not.
