Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "CYDONIA," which is reported to be lying at Milford Haven, after having sustained considerable damage through striking a floating mine in October last, I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them a report from this Society's Surveyor at that port, from which it appears that the vessel is a Constructive Total Loss and has been sold for breaking up purposes, and I am directed to inform you that in all the circumstances the Committee have decided to make a record of "Condemned after striking floating mine 10,49" against the vessel's name in the Register Book, and at the same time to expunge her class in accordance with the usual practice.
