
Wastage was noted in the upper deck plating, framing, scarping arrangements at raised quarter deck and bulkhead plating, and the Surveyors recommend that, for class maintenance, the full Special Survey and all essential repairs should be carried out before the end of this month. The Committee duly confirmed this recommendation, and I shall, therefore, be glad if you will arrange accordingly and advise me of the port of repair in due course.
