Dear Sir,

Referring to your letter of the 15th ultimo regarding the electrical installation in the M/S "UDDU" we beg to acquaint you that the owners state that they can not obtain the new cables required and as a temporary measure they propose to cut out the old arrangement, viz. the single pole overload circuit breaker and the single pole switch for the 54 KW. generator. The fuses of the other generator will then be fitted after the double-pole circuit breaker and the two generators to be coupled to the same switch, using the same fuses. The installation can not be run in parallel.

They state that they would have preferred to cut out the 54 KW. generator completely, but the machine drives the pump for the hydraulic winches and must be run at times.

A sketch of the owners' proposal with the above alterations shown in red is enclosed herewith.

We shall be glad to be informed by cable whether the proposal can be accepted.
