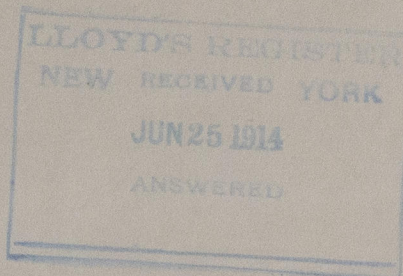

Sir:-

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 4th instant asking if the steamship "Noronic" would be entitled to drawback at \$1.15 per registered ton when the Lloyd's Certificate of Registration does not state the period for which the vessel is classed.

In reply I beg to advise you that the Order-in-Council authorizing the payment of drawback on ship's Materials fixes the rate of drawback according to the period for which the ship is classed, and unless the registrar of shipping is able to complete the Claim in this respect, the Department can only consider the vessel as not classed.

Lloyd's Certificate and other papers are returned to you herewith.

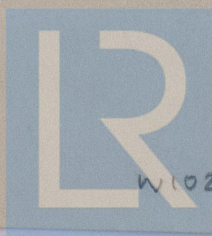
