PROVISIONAL FREEBOARD CERTIFICATE

This is to Certify that

John Stephen

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the owners attend on board the Steamer "NORONIC", 6905 tons gross of Port Arthur, Ontario, 134014 Official Number, for the purpose of assignment of freeboard under the Canada Shipping Act 1934 and Order in Council P.C. 1903.

The vessel substantially and reasonably complies with the provisions of the Order in Council P.C. 1903, and the following freeboard has been assigned by the Committee of this Society while the vessel is engaged in service on the Great Lakes.

Freeboard amidships from top of deck line, steel deck, to center of disc:-

Summer	10 ft. 6½ ins.	
Intermediate	10 ft. 11 ins.	4½ ins. below center of Disc.
Winter	11 ft. 3½ ins.	9½ ins. below center of Disc.

The freeboard markings have been out in on the vessel's sides, and verified, and in my opinion the vessel may safely proceed at those freeboards and only whilst engaged in service on the Great Lakes.

This certificate is provisional and temporary only and is issued during the interim until permanent certificate can be approved and issued.
